

Friday Night Social – Rules

The Arc of Kitsap and Jefferson Counties funds & facilitates this program as a recreational opportunity for adults with developmental disabilities from 4:00pm to 7:00pm on most Fridays. As part of any program The Arc has policies and procedures in place so that everyone will be safe and operate within the constraints of insurance coverage.

Participants

- The event is for Adults 18 years and older only. Anyone 17 years or younger will be asked to leave.
- No alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons are allowed.
- Dance Hall capacity is 300.
- Smoking is only allowed under the tent on the side of the building, 25' from the door.
- Participants must have rides to and from the dance. The Arc will not provide any transportation. Participants must have their own ride home. Staff are not permitted to give rides to or from the dance unless as part of their job with another organization. If a client does not have a ride home then FNS manager will call their residence for assistance.
- If a participant need assistance with feeding or toileting, Arc staff will not be able to assist. Care providers should accompany participant. We are unable to provide direct care.
- Level 3 sexual predators must have a chaperone.
- Participants who violate house rules or are disruptive to the fun and safety of the event may be given a warning, asked not to come back, or be suspended. This determination is made by the FNS manager only. Staff must contact the FNS manager to let them know the situation and then a consequence will be determined if necessary. If a participant is suspended it must be put into an incident report and designated for the length of time the person is suspended. The FNS manager will let the office and dance staff know.
- Once participants arrive at the dance they should remain at the dance until pick up. The Arc will not be responsible for anyone leaving the dance to go to the store or to get food.
- Care providers are responsible for all care of their clients at the dance. Staff may only assist as asked and if it is appropriate.
- All participants must have an emergency contact and registration information form on file at our office. This form must be updated as information is changed. New participants must be sent to the FNS manager to fill out the form for our records.
